In the evening, get a traditional Rajasthani welcome and enjoy delicious tea and snacks while the Rajasthani folk dancers and musicians will entertain you during the around the camp fire. Enjoy a delicious Rajasthani dinner before going to bed in your comfortable tents amidst the desert. In the morning, start your day with a delicious breakfast and a camel ride before ending your trip.

IN FOCUS: THE DESERT FESTIVAL, JAISALMER, RAJASTHAN (January 29 – 31, 2018)



The Jaisalmer Desert Festival is held annually in January or February every year. Exciting events such as cultural events, camel races, camel dance and even turban tying competitions take place at the festival every year. The longest moustache competition is the most anticipated event during the festival. The other most popular highlight of the festival includes the performances by famous Gair and fire dancers. The golden sands of the Thar Desert add an enchanting charm to the festival. This is a three day long extravaganza where the cultures of Rajasthan are on display. It take place in the Golden fortress of Jaisalmer. The Desert Festival is an extensively colorful festival that also offers a shopping experience while focusing on just local heritage and customs.

VENUE PICK: HOTEL SURYAGARH

What is it?

Suryagarh is a stunning luxury hotel on the quieter outskirts of Jaisalmer, about twenty minutes from the city. The hotel has been designed to look like a fort, built entirely out of the locally quarried dabri – yellow sandstone. It has 64 rooms divided across five tiers, the maximum being Palace rooms, then Grand Heritage Rooms, Signature Suites, Luxury Suites and two uber indulgent Jaisalmer Suites.
